To Whom It May Concern:


Rural Community Assistance Corporation (RCAC), Ramona Municipal Water District (District), Ramona residents, and NV5 Consultants have been working collaboratively to bring water and sewer service from the District to residents in Ramona currently using individual wells for water supply and/or on-site septic systems for sewage disposal.

Through grant funding from the the State Water Board, RCAC and the District recently completed a Project Report to determine the feasibility of installing sewer lines to connect residents to the Santa Maria Wastewater Treatment Plant. A more detailed fact sheet regarding this project report is included in this mailing.

We would like to know if property owners within the proposed septic to sewer project area are interested in receiving sewer and/or water service from the District. We are requesting property owners to complete the enclosed survey. Results of the survey will be used to determine support for a potential grant funded sewer line construction project, and to determine support for a water supply project which could justify grant funding for a feasibility study and construction project within the same service area.
