The following survey will help the Rural Community Assistance Corporation (RCAC), the District and the State determine if your residence is eligible for funding under the available grant funding. Responding to the survey will not result in a final commitment on your part to connect to the District, rather it will help RCAC, the District and funding agencies to make decisions regarding further grant applications and funding for water or sewer system improvements, and will help identify the residents that are interested in receiving grant funded incentives for connecting to the District for water or sewer service.
